Motion by Tana Bennett motions to accept Option 1 Junior High Bareback & Saddle bronc 2nd by Brad McKee - Motion Passes Unanimously For the 2023-2024 National High School Rodeo Association year, our state/province has elected to handle the Junior High Bareback & Saddle Bronc Riding Events will be offered for each approved qualifying, practice and/or state/province or district rodeo. They may be held in conjunction with the rodeo or held at a different time and location for each rodeo. They must be offered the same number of times as all the other events, such as pole bending, bull riding, etc. If OPTION 1 is used, all points earned throughout the year and at the state/provincial finals will be applied

toward the All-Around.

Discussion on High School Cutting and Reining Cow Options **MOTION BY Kirk Christiansen 2nd BY Josh Baxter Option #1 for Cutting** OPTION 1: Cutting Horse Event will be offered for each approved qualifying, practice and/or state/province or district rodeo. Cutting may be held in conjunction with the rodeo or held at a different time and location for each rodeo. Cutting must be offered the same number of times as all the other events, such as pole bending, bull riding, etc. All points earned throughout the year and at the state/provincial finals will be applied toward the All Around. **Option #2 for Reined Cow Horse** OPTION 2: Reined Cow Horse Event must be offered a minimum three (3) times within each district and/or state/province and their finals. Only the points earned at the finals will count toward the All Around. Points earned at the qualifying events and the state/provincial finals will be used for the year end Reined Cow Horse Champion.

Discussion on Point System Options – This item was tabled until further clarification could be made concerning the NHSRA ruling to eliminate the Bonus Points

Later on June 12th It was confirmed that National Qualifiers will be determined exactly the same as they were with Option #1 in the past. Going forward bonus points will not be awarded at State Finals which could impact All Around Winners. An email was sent to the board for Vote.
