



Scholarship Program

REQUIREMENTS:

All UHSRA Seniors may apply. Members DO NOT need to be State Qualifiers to apply.

All applicants must meet the criteria below:

1. The candidate must be a member of the Utah High School Rodeo Association.
2. The candidate must present a formal and completed application with all requirements.
3. The candidate must have carried a minimum accumulative "C" average, 2.0.
4. The candidate must turn in an **Official High School TRANSCRIPT** that includes the school's stamp or seal and an authorized signature. (Homeschool included). For students who graduate early, the transcript must reflect all completed coursework and the graduation date. *Transcript must be as up to date as is available at the time of application. Report Cards will not be accepted.
5. The candidate must have been an active participant and supporter of the Utah High School Rodeo Association.
6. The candidate must be a High School Graduating Member.
7. Final decision of acceptance or rejection of the candidates lies with the Executive Board.

APPLICATION:

Completed scholarship applications must be turned in at the mandatory meeting of State Finals on Tuesday evening.

INTERVIEW:

Interviews will be held on Thursday afternoon. A listing of the time and place of the interviews will be posted at the Rodeo Office on Wednesday morning. *The interview is mandatory for all applicants. If you have High School graduation on Thursday, please contact the Scholarship Chairman so an appropriate time can be scheduled for your interview.

SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE:

All unused scholarships will expire in 2 years from the award date unless notification is received of the State Secretary either by email or mail of a request to extend the deadline. Deadline requests are only given for Military or Church Service missions and will be a 2 year extension.

REQUESTING YOUR SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS:

If you receive a scholarship you must submit a copy of proof of enrollment to the State Secretary (something with member name and the school name on it: An acceptance letter, schedule, etc.) This can be submitted by mail or email. Checks will be made out to the school with the member's name in the memo.

- EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** (30 pts. possible, 10 points for each category)

- **Other Clubs/Activity Participation:** List any sports, drama, music, FFA, FHA, or any other school or community clubs you have participated in.

- **Leadership:** List any leadership opportunities you have had including rodeo student officer, school clubs, civic or church roles. These are leadership positions, not just participation.

- **Community Service:** List any community service you have done including service projects, church or scouting service, or volunteer work.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION: (5 pts. possible)

- Attach at least one letter of recommendation from someone outside of your immediate family.

I understand that if my application is not complete and I do not attend the interview, my application will not be accepted.
