Review and vote on proposed rule change: **UHSRA & UHJRA Rough Stock Approval Process**

All stock must be approved by the UHSRA livestock committee and then voted on by the UHSRA board for approval.

Stock contractor needs to own sufficient rough stock animals (not leased or rented) that are branded by stock contractor seeking approval.

- o 15 bareback horses
- o 20 saddle bronc horses
- o 30 bulls

Stock contractor must produce at least 10 rodeos per year to be eligible.

Stock contractor must submit resumes for the following help they intend to use at a UHSRA or UHJRA event. Resumes need to include events worked and experience with rodeo events.

- o Pickup men
- o Bullfighters
 - Any help with convicted felonies needs to be approved by the UHSRA board prior to helping at any events.
 - All help must be at least 18 years of age per NHSRA rules.

Stock contractor must submit contact information from at least 3 previous events that they have produced.

Stock contractor must be able to supply animals suitable for the Junior Varsity and High School division.

o Numbers will vary depending on the years.

Stock contractor must have UHSRA board approval 60 days before being eligible to produce a UHSRA event.

Motion:

Brad McKee made a motion to approve the proposed rule change as presented.

Second:

The motion was seconded by Darrell Sagers.

Vote Outcome:

- **Result:** Motion passed by majority vote.

Notes:

The approved rule change will be implemented immediately and added to the official UHSRA rulebook.
